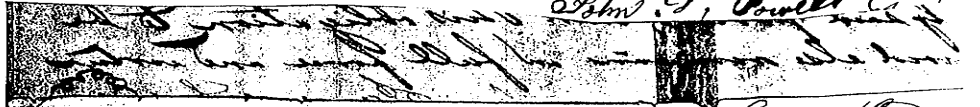

The Condition of the oblige above is such
that whereas the above bound Marshall Neal
is about to obtain a license to marry Miss Martha
Song daughter of ~~John~~ ~~Robert~~ Song
of this County he having personally assented to the same
Now then if there should be no lawful cause to
detract the marriage intended to be solemnized by
the within named parties then this obligation
to be void, else remain in full force & effect
